I want to express my heartfelt appreciation to each and everyone of you for your support, prayers and dedication to our church. It has been a privilege alongside such an amazing community.



The National Council in her November 2025 session after fasting and prayers and being led by the Holy Spirit's directives, came out with the following decisions:

1. TACC NATIONAL PRESIDENT:

Apostle **MBOKWANG JOHN FRU** is the National President of The Apostolic Church Cameroon as from 1st January 2026, according to the provisions of the Constitution of the church will last for a period of five year term of office.



2. **TACC NATIONAL VICE PRESIDENT:**

Apostle **DIWOUTA JACQUES** is the National Vice President of The Apostolic Church Cameroon as from 1st January 2026, according to the Constitution of the church will last for a period of five year term of office.

11. **NATIONAL, FIELD AND GROUP CONVENTIONS:**



The National Council took the following decisions with the objective to relieve the Christians from financial burdens and to encourage development at the level of the Fields and Groups:

- a. **National Conventions:** That henceforth, National Conventions shall hold every three years (**Triennial Convention**) and two years for transition purpose.
- b. **Field Conventions:** Henceforth, the first year of every regime is scheduled for Field Conventions all over the national territory respecting the National Council Calendar. This will commence as from 1st January 2026.
- c. **Group Conventions:** That henceforth, the second year of every regime is scheduled for Group Conventions all over the national territory according to the national calendar. This will commence as from 1st January 2027.
- d. **Transition and Handing-Over:** The handing-over / transition of the President / Vice shall henceforth take place during the National Convention at the end of the second segment of every regime i.e. the first segment is three years and the second segment is two years.

12. **AUTONOMOUS ASSEMBLY:**

The following assemblies have been approved by the National Council as autonomous assemblies and will go operational as from 1st January 2026. They are:

- a. Field 9: Gardens in Group 19
- b. Field 16: New Jerusalem Assembly in Dibanda.

13. **NEW DISTRICTS:**

The following new districts have been created by the National Council effective as from 1st January 2026, they are:

- a. Field 10:
 - i. Yagoua in Group 38 made up of Yagoua itself, Tcheke and Toukou.
 - ii. Doukoula in Group 38 made up of Doukoulan itself, Guissia, Sirlawe, Glontchai and Mindif.
- b. Field 11:
 - i. PK 10 in Group 17 made up of PK 10 itself and Génie Militaire.

14. **RE-DEPLOYMENT / WITHDRAWAL OF CLERICAL:**

Rev. Nyang Oliver is re-deployed from Njikwa as per the Circular of August 2025, to Kake II, Kumba as from the 17th November 2025. He will function in Kake center submitting to the District Pastor of Mile One. The District Pastor of Mile One shall carry out the following: Communion service, and extension of R.H.F. His clerical has been withdrawn and he shall not attend Group meetings till further notice.



15. **MISSIONS**

- a) **EMISAH:** The Missions School in the North of Cameroon now has a new name approved by the NC. It is called Sahel Mission School. (EMISAH)
- b) **National Missions Support:** Henceforth, the NC has decided that 1% of tithes balance after expenses will be deducted from the assembly sheet for Missions and forwarded to the H.Q. The description shall be Missions Fund.

16. **RETIREMENT:**

The NC in her November 2025 session decided that henceforth effective from 1st January 2026, each Pastor shall contribute the sum of 2,000frs monthly for retirement. The deductions shall be made from the Pastoral sheets.

17. **THEME OF THE YEAR AND MOTTO FOR 2026:**

The Theme of the year 2026 is **"MY YEAR OF GREATER HOPE"**

The Motto of the year 2026 is **"I WILL HOPE IN THE LORD CONTINUALLY, AND PRAISE HIM MORE AND MORE" PSALM 71:14.**

This Theme of the year and Motto of the church shall be displayed on a banner and or flex, shall be developed and used in teachings and preachings in all The Apostolic Church congregations in Cameroon. This Motto shall be recited thrice after every service and church meetings. All the Field Superintendents, Group Supervisors and Pastors shall enforce it so that there will be uniformity in all our churches

May the Lord bless you all, and may you celebrate the joy of this season and remain expectant, Jesus is coming soon. Merry Christmas and Happy New year 2026.
