The National Council, during her March 2026 session, held from Monday 23rd Thursday 26th March 2026 in Ntoko Street-Kumba, under deep meditation and guidance of the Holy Spirit, the following decisions were arrived at:

1. **NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COUNCIL SECRETARY:** Apostle Dr. Enow Tabi Martin has been appointed the National Executive Council Secretary with effect from 1st April 2026.

2. **NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEMBER:** Apostle Jean Marie Ndakwe has been appointed a National Executive Council member with effect from 1st April 2026.

3. **ASSISTANT NATIONAL GENERAL SECRETARY:** Rev. Kuiuessie Etienne has been appointed the Assistant National General Secretary with effect from 1st April 2026.

4. **ASSISTANT FIELD SUPERINTENDENT:** Rev. Ngwasiri Ezekiel has been appointed an Assistant Field Superintendent with effect from 1st April 2026.

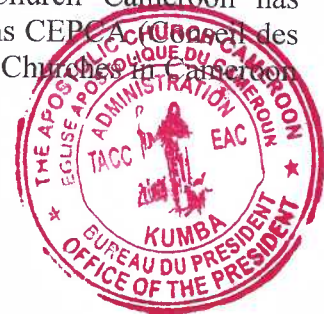
5. **ASSISTANT GROUP SUPERVISORS:** The following Pastors have been appointed Assistant Group Supervisors with effect from 1st April 2026, they are Rev. Nyenty Stephen and Rev. Azangue Emmanuel.

7. **NATIONAL YOUTH SECRETARY:** Rev. Malachi Timti has been appointed the National Youth Secretary with effect from 1st April 2026.
8. **NATIONAL MISSIONS BOARD:** Rev. Dr. Awa Anwanda has been appointed a member of the National Missions Board as from the 1st April 2026.
9. **NATIONAL WOMEN COMMITTEE:** The following Sisters have been appointed members of the National Women Committee with effect from 1st April 2026, they are: Sister Mbu Mineva and Sister Manka Loveline.
10. **WOMEN DEPARTMENT IN FIELD 14:** Rev. Jean Kue will work with the Field Secretary General of Field 14 to represent the Women Movement in Field 14 Council.
11. **NATIONAL LAND COORDINATOR:** Pastor Ngnintadem Emmanuel has been appointed the National Coordinator for Lands in The Apostolic Church Cameroon with effect from 1st April 2026. He will work in synergy with Rev. Sombe Simon.
12. **TABS ANNEX YAOUNDE:** The following Pastors have been appointed into principal offices in TABS Annex Yaounde, they are:
 - a. Director: Rev. Daniel Hiol
 - b. Registrar: Pastor Ambomo Joel
 - c. Academic Dean: Rev. Rikam Jean A.
 - d. Bursar: Takang Christopher.
13. **ORDINATION:** Pastor Desmond Forwang of Field 14 has been approved for Ordination, this will be done in Field 14 Convention at Texas.
14. **NEW CALLS:** The following brethren in Field 14 have been called into the Pastoral Ministry, they are Ndemazeh Fritz and Joshua Njom Ayire.
15. **NEW FIELD:** The following new Field has been created with effect from 1st July 2026:
 - a. **Bertoua Field (Field 18)** made up of Group 11 Bertoua and Group 50 Abongmbang with headquarters in Bertoua.
16. **NEW GROUP:** The following new Group has been created with effect from 1st July 2026:
 - a. **Wum Group (Group 64):** under Field 3, made up of the following districts: Wum itself (Group headquarters), Benakuma, Bafmen, Esuh and Weh.
17. **CEPCA:** The National Council of The Apostolic Church Cameroon has approved that The Apostolic Church Cameroon now joins CEPCA (Conseil des Eglises Protestantes du Cameroon) Council of Protestant Churches in Cameroon as a full member.



18. **WELFARE DEPARTMENT:** The National Council has approved a Welfare Department in TACC; known as Apostolic Social Welfare and Development Department, (ASOWEDD).
19. **NEW DISTRICTS:** The following new districts have been created in Field 3 and will go operational as from the 1st July 2026, they are:
 - a. Ntenefor District, consisting of Ntenefor and Ntasin assemblies.
 - b. Bafmeng distict, made up of Bafmeng and Ipali assemblies.
20. **NEW AUTONOMOUS CENTRE:** The following Autonomous Centre has been created, which will go operational as from 1st July 2026:
 - a. **Mengoh Autonomous Centre:** made up of Mengoh and Bévé 2 Assemblies under Galim District in Group 16 Galim – Field 8.
 - b. **Bilik Centre:** made up of Bilik, Obam-Febe and La Aource assemblies under Emana District in Group 40
21. **AUTONOMOUS ASSEMBLIES:** The following Autonomous Assemblies have been created, which will go operational as from the 1st July 2026, they are:
 - a. **Field 2:** Ndongo Autonomous Assembly from Molyko District in Group 46.
 - b. **Field 4:** Dibombari Autonomous Assembly from Souza District in Group 54
Payage Autonomous Assembly from Mbanga District in Group 28
Mombo Autonomous Assembly from Mbanga District in Group 28.
 - c. **Field 12:** Ebebda Autonomous Assembly from Monatela District in Group 51.
22. **READJUSTMENT OF DISTRICTS AND CENTRES:** The following adjustment are made in districts and centres effective from 1st July 2026, they are:
 - a. Ekounou and Tiyro as a Centre attached to the district of Bertoua (Group 11, Field 18)
 - b. Mbandjock and Pioneer Camp Centre attached to Nkoteng district (Group 31, Field 12)
 - c. Mbama and Edjen Centre attached to the district of Saa (Group 51, Field 12)
 - d. Ekabita and Komotou Centre attached to Nkozooa district (Group 40, Field 12)
 - e. Mbama in the East joins Messamena District (Group 50, Field 18).
 - f. Mississippi joins Siosio (Group 57, Field 11).
23. **TABS DAY:** 12th of April, 2026 in all assemblies of TACC.
24. **ADMISSIONS INTO TABS KUMBA AND YAOUNDE:** The National Church is informed of the Admissions currently going on in TABS Kumba and TABS Annex Yaoundé, the date has been scheduled for 30th May 2026. This announcement should be made in all churches for prospective candidates to see TABS offices and compile the necessary documents.



25. **EXCHANGE OF PULPIT FOR NATIONAL CATHEDRAL:** Sunday 12th August 2026 has been reserved nationwide for exchange of pulpit for the National Cathedral. Superintendents and Supervisors should organise for a smooth running and successful exchange of pulpit for the building of God's Temple at the National Headquarters.
26. **NATIONAL MEN'S SUNDAY:** The National Council has set-aside every First Sunday June of every year as NATIONAL MEN'S SUNDAY. In effect all men shall dress in their uniforms and every activity shall be tailored to promote the dynamism and encouragement of the movement.
27. **TRANSFERS:** The following transfers have been made to take effect as from 1st June 2026:
